Autumn Series FINAL

The wind was strong enough at 2pm to think about cancelling but we went ahead and the wind moderated, at times it was quite calm. Now that it almost the end of Autumn there are leaves in the pond that caught on a few keels and rudders.

A course was set with a couple of zig-zags but after a couple of races an extra zig-zag was added to give better windward legs. Seven members turned out for the racing.



Race 1 had George Stead, Laurie Glover and Tom Clark lead around lap 1. Going to the top mark in lap 2 Laurie went too far left and lost out while Mike Renner made big gains on the right. On the long downwind Mike was able to push through to take the lead (left). Going to the final mark Mike and Tom were side by side but Mike had the

inside overlap and could round ahead to take the win.

In **race 2** Brian Chritensen sped out to large lead but the wind died on the long downwind and came up from behind to bring several boats up to him. Tom was given two penalties at the bottom mark, one for barging with no buoy room and then touching the mark on his recovery from that. He soon overcame this and in lap two he took the lead from Laurie and George. Closer to the finish Tom went the wrong way on a windward and dropped back. At the finish it was George with Laurie right on his transom.

Race 3 was George again, followed by Tom and Laurie.

Race 4 had Peter Rickerby take a large lead and be around the first mark and away on the downwind while the wind died for the rest of the fleet. The rest of



the fleet kept as close group (above) and this probably slowed them down in their chase of Peter. Alan Watson had a power failure and went ashore. Peter took the win followed by Tom and Laurie.

Race 5 had Mike lead for some of the way but Tom took over on the downwind while Brian held on and George joined this group. At the finish it was George, again, with Tom and Brian placing.

In **race 6** Brian made the most of the divisional start and led at the top mark. Going into lap two he still led but Tom was half a length behind. Mike was still holding off Laurie at this point but at the finish Tom took the win with Brian second and Laurie third.

Tom Clark was top boat today with one win and a string of second places giving him 9 points. George Stead was second on 10 points with 3 wins. Laurie Glover was third with 15 points. Other wins went to Mike Renner and Peter Rickerby.
